Buildings

The following pages show the entries in the Buildings category of the 2021 model competition. Voting takes place online, and all members will be emailed voting instructions and a unique voting ID.

B2. Alston Station

The model is based on a professional digital survey of the building obtained from the architects who designed recent improvements to the station for the South Tynedale Preservation Society. The digital drawings provided were adapted and were used as a basis for laser cutting of doors, windows and walls. The 'brickpaper' for the walls was based on photographs of the stonework of the actual building printed out to scale. The chimneys were drawn using a free 3D digital drawing package and 3D printed.





B18. Row of Cottages

This is my first attempt at 2mm scale modelling. It is a row of cottages in Derbyshire. I saw the prototype in a book about architecture and worked out the dimensions using the doorways as the starting point. The rear elevation is pure conjecture.



B19. Freelance Footbridge

The design is freelance but similar to several seen in real life and books. I have made, and discarded, enough parts to build three bridges but there have only been enough that were fit to use to make one.



B21. Tavistock GWR Footbridge

The footbridge at Tavistock spanned 3 tracks that had originally been laid in broad gauge days so was wider than many similar footbridges.

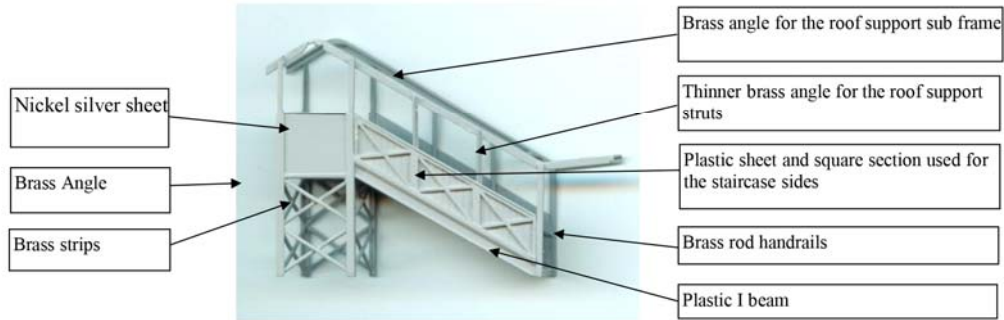
The model has been made from a combination of nickel silver sheet, brass strip and angle plus various parts made from plastic sheet and strip as indicated in one of the attached jpg files.

It is comprised of 4 parts - the two side staircases, the cross piece spanning the tracks and the roof section. The latter two parts are removable to enable easier access to the tracks below for track cleaning

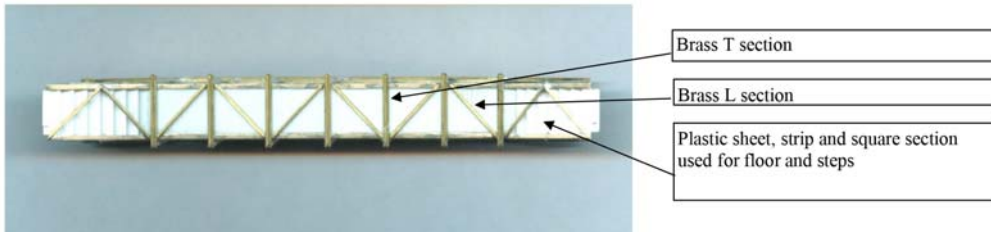
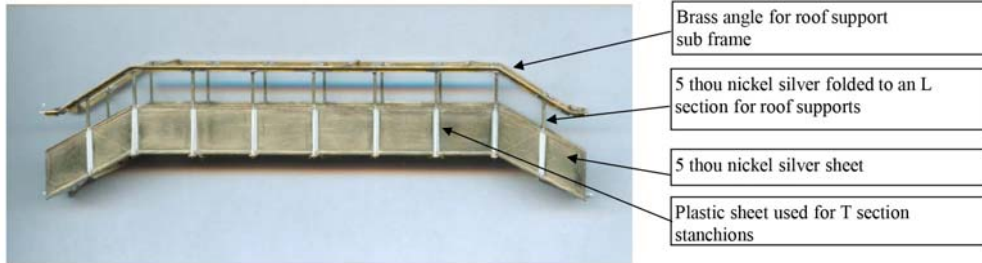


Tavistock GWR Footbridge - 2mm Scale

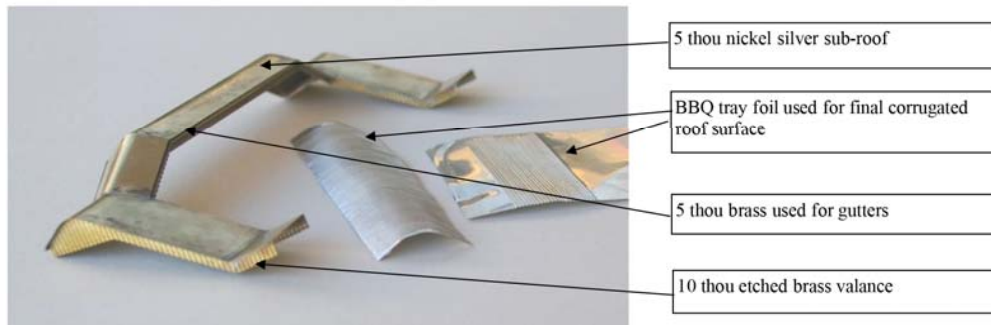
Side Staircases

B29. Highland Signal Box

Highland signal box scratchbuilt in plasticard with etched windows. The roof is corrugated iron made using tin foil and a serated coffee pot lid.
